Mr. Bob Porter, 84, of Ashdown, AR, passed away Sunday, May 24, 2015 in a Texarkana, Texas hospital. Bob was born April 29, 1931 to Mid J. and Hattie Porter in Kirby, Arkansas. Bob was a member and deacon of Central Baptist Church in Ashdown, Arkansas. He was retired from Arkansas State Police after 30 years of service and then served as Chief of Police in Ashdown for 10 years. Through the years, Bob was involved in many civic activities in the community such as past President of the Ashdown Kiwanis Club, Chairman of the American Cancer Society, American Heart Association, Ashdown City Park Board, Board of Arkansas Western District Drug Task Force; and the Arkansas State Police Association.
