September 23, 1928 - July 19, 2024

CT "Tony" Spigner, 95, of Ashdown, Arkansas passed away July 19, 2024, at St Michael's hospital in Texarkana, Texas. He was born September 23, 1928 in Ben Lomond, Arkansas to Bennie Wesley and Ruby Maude Walker Spigner. CT was a graduate of Ashdown High School, and continued his education at the University of Arkansas earning a Bachelor of Science in 1956 and a Master of Administration in 1980. CT started his career as a teacher and coach at DeKalb, Texas, then at Ashdown, Arkansas, from 1956-1967. In 1967, he began working in management at various industries around Arkansas. Upon retirement, he and his wife settled back in Ashdown, Arkansas, where he served Little River County as chief deputy, and served the City of Ashdown as Ward III councilman 1987-2010. He loved sports and enjoyed for decades working as a referee in high school football games. CT was a Korean War Navy veteran, avid golfer and domino player. He often boasted that he was the oldest golfer at the Little River Country Club.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his brothers Bink Spigner and Glenn Spigner, his sister Susie Dellinger and brother-in-law Pat Dellinger, all of Ashdown. He is survived by his wife of 71 years, Vyvian, his daughters Teresa Spigner and Janice Spigner of Ashdown, his daughter LEEANNE Wisdom of Ore City, Texas, and his son Tom Spigner and wife Sonia of Beebe, Arkansas. Also surviving are 7 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren, his sisters-in-law Daisy Dean Spigner and Marsha Spigner of

Ashdown, along with many nieces, nephews and friends.
