



## Mr David Mullins

August 5, 1926 - June 5, 2015

Mr. David Breckenridge Mullins of Texarkana, AR passed away in a local nursing home, June 5, 2015. He was born in Red Bluff, AR to the late Mack Henry and Edna Margaret Combs Mullins. He grew up on the family farm where he learned the love of God, family, the values of hard work and love of the land. He was a Baptist. He attend elementary school at the nearby Blackerby School and graduated in 1945 from Ashdown High School. Upon graduation he was drafted into the U.S. Army and was enroute to the Pacific Theatre when WWII ended. After returning home in 1946 he enrolled in the Pharmacy Program at the College of the Ozarks, at Clarksville, AR. With Funding through the G.I. Bill he completed the degree requirements for a Bachelor of Science in three years instead of the usual four and graduated in 1949. After completion of additional studies, he was awarded a Doctor of Pharmacy by the College of the Ozarks in 1981. While at college he met the love of his life, Aleta Louise Yarbrough of Johnson County, AR. They married on August 20, 1949.

Mr. Mullins was preceded in death by his sister, Dorothy Maxine Mullins and a brother, Mack Henry "Pete" Mullins, Jr.
