Dorothy Lynn Sellers, 87, of Ashdown, AR passed away on Saturday, June 6, 2020 at her home. Mrs. Sellers was born August 1, 1932 to Walter and Vera Hill Pruitt in Ashdown. She was preceded in death by her husband, Carol Flynn Sellers.

Lynn was a member of First Baptist Church of Ashdown. She was retired from First National Bank after 30 years of service, a charter member of Little River County Arts Council and Little River Historical Society. She was also a founding member of the Two Rivers Museum in Ashdown. She was a very accomplished realist (oil on canvas) artist who received over a hundred awards for her art. She was the Four States Regional artist of the year in 1999.
