Jacqueline Dixon Wiseman was born November 24, 1948 in Pine Bluff, AR. Her sunlight shined bright for 77 years until God decided that her service was no longer needed nor required here on earth. Jacqueline's sun set on June 09, 2026 at her home surrounded by family.

Jacqueline united with St. Matthew Baptist Church at an early age. She was a Sunday school teacher, Vacation Bible school teacher, member of the Usher board, and church clerk. Jacqueline also served several years as the Little River District correspondence secretary. She was one of the founding members of the C.A.P.P. initiative (Community Alternative Prevention Program), Community Food Pantry, and played an intricate part in St. Matthew's Project Mustard Seed. After her mother passed, Jacqueline stepped into Mrs. Helen's unfinished business by holding offices in Kiwanis and Foreman City Council.
