



## Mary Frances Jeans

July 30, 1929 - August 13, 2020

Mary Frances Adkison Jeans, 91, departed this life on Thursday, August 13, 2020, and was reunited with her late husband, Robert Edward “Sonny” Jeans.

Frances was born on July 30, 1929 to the late Marion Francis Adkison, and Lavinia Charlotte Ford Adkison. Frances was the third of six children born in the family.
