Michael Wayne Dixon, 61, was born October 25, 1957 in Foreman, AR. He departed this life on May 10, 2019. He united with the St. Matthew Baptist Church at an early age and was the teacher of class #2. Michael was a trailblazer. He was one on the first African-American children in Foreman to integrate Foreman Public Schools in 1966 and later graduated in the Class of 1977. After graduation, Michael joined the United States Air Force. After completing 4 years of service, he was awarded an Honorable discharge. Michael returned home to hunt and fish. He worked for Foreman Public School District for many years in the following capacities: school bus driver, substitute teacher, maintenance crew, Pee Wee Coach (football, basketball). Michael was preceded in death by his father, Ulysses Dixon and one brother, Ronald Charles Dixon.
