Virginia Ford Eskew, age 94, of Ashdown, Arkansas completed her earthly journey through life and went home to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on May 23, 2025. Virginia was the daughter of Nettie Lee Hinton Ford and Rufus Ford. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband of 56 years, James Roy Eskew, her son, Jimmy Eskew, her sister and brother-in-law Barbara and Joe Spigner, and two special aunts, Louise Phillips (Homer) and Lois Smith (Johnny). Virginia is survived by two grandsons, James Matthew (April) and Chad Michael (Rachel), Matt's sons, Taylor and Tripp Eskew, special niece, Angela Spigner Conaway (Morgan), and a host of friends and other relatives.
