



## Paul F. Hale

January 24, 1953 - March 13, 2024

Paul Fredrick Hale, 71, entered peacefully into God's presence on March 13, 2024, in Ashdown, Arkansas. A lifelong resident of the Ashdown community, he spent his last days surrounded by family and friends.

Paul was born Jan. 24, 1953. He was involved in Cub Scouts and the Civil Air Patrol before graduating from Ashdown High School in 1971. After attending the University of Arkansas in Fayetteville, he returned to Peytonville to work as a farmer for many decades on the family farm. He served thirty years as a Little River Conservation District board member and was also on the board of the Little River County Historical Society. He was involved in the Ashdown High School Alumni Association, the Two Rivers Museum and the First United Methodist men's group. His hobbies included archery, hunting and guitar, and he passed his love and knowledge of these skills on to others.

A kindhearted family hero, Paul was preceded in death by his parents, Don and Pauline (Scott) Hale. He is survived by three brothers, Don Hale Jr. and Bill (Donna) Hale of Ashdown, and Daniel J. Hale of Dallas, Texas; two sisters, Kathy (David) Womble of Ashdown and Gale (Don) LaBrot of Caddo Mills, Texas; and a host of nieces, nephews and long-time friends.
