Randell Glenn Carrell (69) of Foreman, AR passed away on December 4, 2018 in Texarkana, TX after a long battle with illness.

Randell was born on October 27, 1949 in Kingston Springs, TN to Harvey and Georgia (Bennett) Carrell. He was the twelfth of fourteen children.

On December 14, 1968, Randell married Jane Grace in Enid, OK, with whom he spent almost fifty years of love. Shortly after their wedding, Randell served in the U.S. Army from 1969-1971 during the Vietnam Conflict.

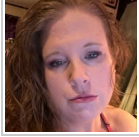
