



## Tracy Pounds

September 29, 1955 - December 15, 2023

Long time Atlanta Texas resident Tracy Pounds, 68, passed away on December 15th, 2023 after a short illness. Tracy was born in Albuquerque, NM on September 29, 1955 to Joe Bob and Margie Faye Pounds. Her parents preceded her in death.

Tracy's love of animals was second to none. During her lifetime she owned many different kinds of animals, all of which were cherished and well cared for. She was well known in the Ark-La-Tex area for her work with dogs. Known as the "Dobelady" to some, she trained and showed her doberman pinscher dogs over the years, winning many awards and multiple championships. Tracy was a member of the Texarkana Kennel Club, taught obedience training, participated in many dog shows and was a member of the Four States Search and Rescue, and worked with the Bowie County Sheriff's Office with Search and Rescue for a number of years. While attending college she taught horseback riding to other college students and led trail rides at the Este Enda Ranch in Sanger Tx.

A graduate of North Texas State University, Tracy worked as a Graphics Designer for the Atlanta Citizens Journal, Texarkana College and Texas A&M University-Texarkana. She also owned her own Graphics Design business and provided artwork to many magazines and other publications.

Tracy is survived by her brothers, Joe Pounds and wife Jennifer Pounds of Mena Arkansas and Michael Pounds of Austin Texas, nephew Ryan Pounds and wife Ashlyn, and their children Ryan Jr., Erik, and Kendall Pounds all of Union Grove Texas, and her lifelong friend Leslie Jo Jackson of Denton Texas. Other survivors include many cousins in Texas and Arkansas as well as many close friends made over the years.

Tracy will be missed, but we will hold her in our hearts until we meet again.

# Tribute Wall

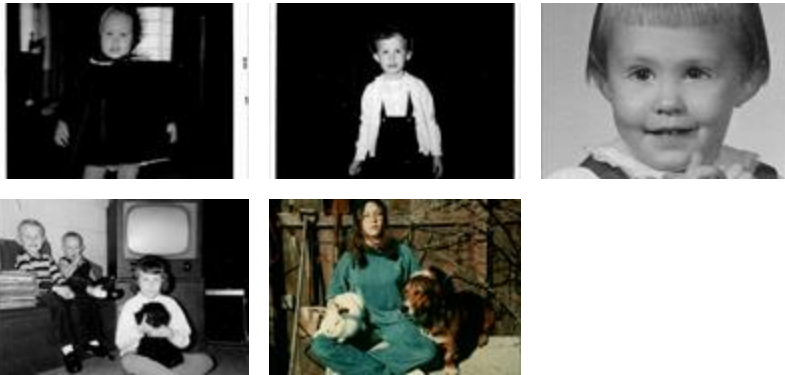
